Today, global crises including war and natural disaster have displaced an estimated 42 million people, 40% of whom are children. 1.5 billion children, over two-thirds of the world's child population, have faced some type of emergency situation. Research has shown that childhood is a vital period for brain development and has validated the crucial importance of quality early interaction between young children and their immediate environment.

The ECD Kit is a package containing early-learning, play, and psychosocial materials that address the developmental progress of children from birth to age six.
