If a spring compressor is required for your job, this is where you'd use it. There should be three bolts holding the bottom of the strut in place, which you can loosen with a socket wrench.

What to Know Before Replacing Your Own Shocks or Struts ...

The usual way to test a shock absorber is to push down on a corner of the vehicle a few times to get it to bounce and then stop pushing and see how much it continues to bounce before stopping. A good shock absorber should stop the bouncing right away. If it bounces several times then the shock absorber is considerably worn.

Spray the upper and lower shock mounting nuts and absorbers with the penetrating oil and allow the oil to soak into the parts before attempting to remove. Wait at least 10 minutes. Step 4 Dislodge the lower and upper mounting nuts and washers with the wrench and pliers, and remove the old shock absorber.

Step 1 - Before removing a shock absorber its important to know that a shock limits the downward travel of the suspension. Start by relieving the tension of the suspension by positioning a jack under the lower ball joint or control arm while raising the jack upward slightly. (Note: Not performing this step can make shock replacement difficult.)
